Fields of manoeuvre

Preparations for the next seven years in the European Union are taking place on several fronts. Outstanding are the labours on the future of the Structural Funds, and about the final shape of the coming Creative Europe programme.

The expansion of the culture sector by annexing the creative industries has been topical for nearly twenty years now. The other issue has lately gained momentum: the self-centric penchants of the sector have increasingly given way to emphasising the social impact of culture, manifested by a strong focus on <u>audience development</u>.

EU	Structural Funds	Creative Europe
Creativity annexation	✓	✓
Sector extraversion	✓	✓

All these have found various manifestations in the past weeks.

Expansion fever

The same source, from which we <u>illustrated</u> our warning about the indiscriminate use the term "cultural and creative sector" has <u>reconfirmed now</u> that culture represents about a fifth or fourth in the expanded remit. (Tumover shares of the various branches of cultural and creative industries in Germany in 2010.)



When citing those impressive figures about the creative sector, better avoid sounding like the mouse telling the elephant: "Wow, we are making this bridge shakel"




